Nitty Gritty Facts

Reservations ~ To make your reservations, please call our toll-free number (877.667.3999) or email dude@sylvandale.com. We are happy to hold your space for 2 weeks while awaiting your deposit.

Deposit ~ A deposit of 30% of the total package rate is due within 2 weeks. For groups of 20 or more, we ask for an additional deposit of 20% of the total package at least 90 days prior to scheduled arrival.

Payments ~ Final payment is due at check out, but you are welcome to prepay. Personal and traveller checks are cheerfully accepted, as well as MasterCard and Visa.

Cancellations ~ For reservations of less than 20 people, the 30% deposit is refundable if cancellation is made at least 90 days prior to planned arrival (less \$50 service charge per person). Deposits for groups of 20 or more people are not refundable. We recommend Traveler's Insurance to protect your deposit.

Transportation from Airport ~ Most guests rent cars at Denver International Airport (DIA) for convenience and increased sightseeing options. If you need a shuttle from DIA to Loveland, we can provide information and our courtesy van from Loveland to Sylvan Dale.

Smoke-Free Environment ~ In order to assure all our guests a safe and healthy stay, there is no smoking inside any Sylvan Dale building or on the trails.

Alcohol Policy ~ Sylvan Dale serves fine wines and micro-brews. State law does not allow you to bring your own alcoholic beverages into the dining room or other gathering places.

Horseback Riding

Our riding program is designed to offer an adventure for everyone. Whether you are an experienced rider or a first-timer, you will appreciate the quality of our herd and the competence of our wranglers. To assure your safety, we will select your mount for the week and help you choose rides suitable to your skill level.

Sylvan Dale’s registered quarter horses are bred, raised and trained right here! Our qualified wranglers will provide practical in-depth riding instruction. Over 3200 acres bordering Roosevelt National Forest means many miles of beautiful backcountry riding. Our horses and cattle are the heart of our program! We have two official Cattle Drive Weeks in July; in addition, every week includes some cattle moving opportunities.

Please Note: For the sake of safety, all riders (regardless of age) must demonstrate the ability to handle their horse independently before being allowed to head out on the trails.

- Rider weight limit - 250 lbs.
- Trail rides are reserved for ages 6 & up
- No double riding

Fishing

Sylvan Dale waters are teeming with brightly colored rainbow trout, brown trout and large-mouth bass. In addition to catch-and-keep fishing in our stocked ponds, professional local guides can provide flyfishing instruction and excursions to our trophy trout and bass lakes for an additional charge. A Colorado license is required only for river flyfishing.
